Q: Where is Finger Food Advanced Technology Group based?

A: Finger Food Advanced Technology Group is based in Port Coquitlam, BC and now has offices in Calgary, AB, Denver, CO, and London, ON, with satellite offices in Kelowna, BC and San Francisco, CA.

Q: When was Finger Food Advanced Technology Group founded?

A: Finger Food Advanced Technology Group builds custom technology solutions to solve some of the most complex problems faced by businesses today. A: While Finger Food does own certain proprietary technologies, it is a professional services company at heart, and builds products and solutions for its clients.
